

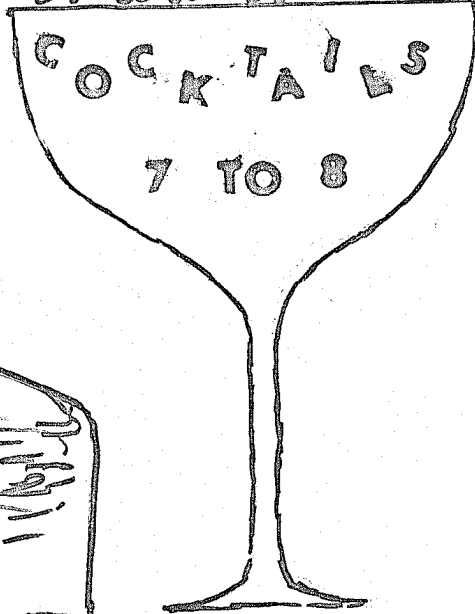

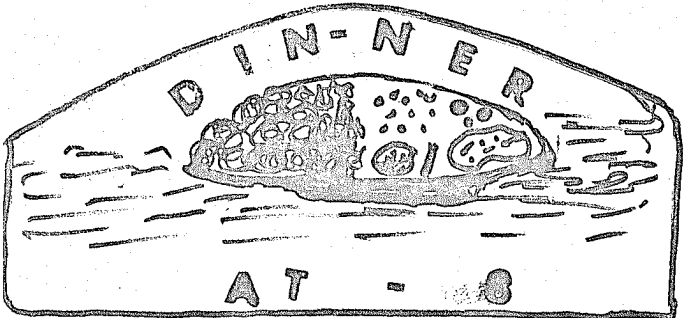

At the meeting held February 8, five Directors were elected, each for a two-year term. The five are Harry Ernest, Skip Pettit, Jack Fenzl, Carl Raymond and Murch Baham. The first meeting of the new Board of Directors has already been scheduled and at that time the Flag Officers will be elected as provided for in our Constitution. The new slate of officers for the coming season will be announced at the Commodore's Ball on February 26.

Incidentally, we had a much better ballot showing in this election than at any time in the past. An increase of about ten per cent, such as just occurred, indicates an increasingly healthy interest in how Tuscarora is run and an awareness of its real value to each of us.

The dredging that was undertaken on the south side of the Island has been completed. The channel, from the bridge to a distance of about 300 feet east, now has a depth fairly uniform, average, depth of four and one-half feet.

Shortly, because of the weather, we are going to have to get started on the work to be done and any lack in manpower will bring about early Week Party assignments. 
