NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 Racing will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Any racing rule changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions.

2 ADVERTISING

Advertising will be restricted to Category A.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 All monohull keelboats with a valid PHRF-LO certificate are eligible to race. If a boat does not have a current PHRF-LO certificate a provisional rating will be assigned by the WHYRA handicapper (Brian Murray) at registration for an additional fee.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and bringing it, together with the required fee, to to the skipper's meeting. Entry forms will be available at the skipper's meeting and on the WHYRA web site at www.whyra.org.

4 FEES

The entry fee is \$25. Entry forms will be available on the WHYRA web site at www.whyra.org and at the skipper's meeting.

5 SERIES AND CLASSES

- 5.1 A maximum of three races will be sailed. One race shall constitute a series.
- 5.2 Boats shall be assigned a class prior to the beginning of the regatta determined by their PHRF rating and whether the rating is based on the use of a spinnaker.

6 SCHEDULE

- 6.1 A skipper's meeting will be held at 10:00 AM on September 8th, 2007 at the Tuscarora Yacht Club clubhouse. Registration will be open starting at 9:00 AM.
- 6.2 The first warning signal will be at approximately 11:00 AM for all classes. Each succeeding race will begin as soon as practicable following the completion of the previous race. Each race is expected to last no longer than 1.5 hours.

7 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid PHRF-Lake Ontario certificate. Certificates may be obtained from the WHYRA handicapper.

8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at the Skipper's Meeting and on the WHYRA web site at www.whyra.org.

9 VENUE

Racing will take place around marks outside of Wilson Harbor.

10 SCORING

A modified version of the low-point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply. PHRF handicapping will utilize the time-on-time method.

11 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the first three places in each class. The awards ceremony will be at the Tuscarora Yacht Club clubhouse. It will begin approximately one hour after the race committee boat docks (signaled by one sound signal.)

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in racing entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. WHYRA will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the racing.

13 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
